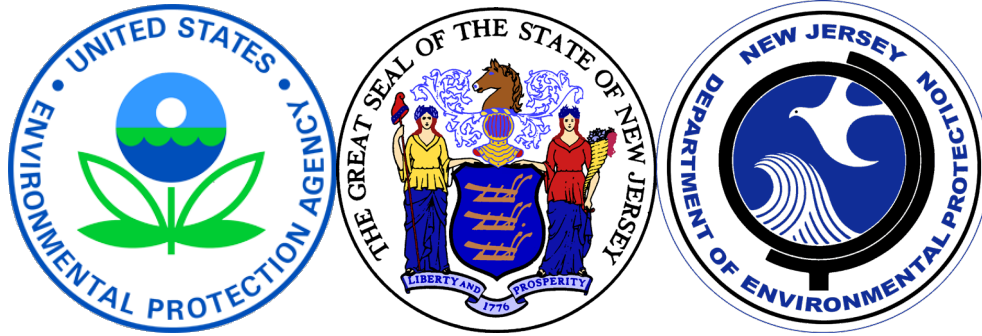




Construction of upgrades and improvements to the Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission (PVSC), Advanced Electrical Contract II Project located in the City of Newark, Essex County, with a capital cost of approximately \$78,000,000 were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (Infrastructure Bank) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the Infrastructure Bank to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits by upgrading the electrical infrastructure at the PVSC wastewater treatment facility. Upgrading the electrical infrastructure will provide reliable operations at the wastewater treatment facility for residents and businesses in the Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission Sewer District.

State Revolving Fund programs around the nation provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure protecting our valuable water resources nationwide.
